

DISCLOSURE OF THE RELEVANT INDICATORS IN THE ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY FOR IDENTIFYING SISTEMICALLY IMPORTANT BANKS AT A GLOBAL LEVEL AS AT 31 DECEMBER 2022 (ART. 441 OF REGULATION EU 575/2013)

The Basel Committee on Banking Supervision (BCBS) has developed an assessment methodology to identify Global Systemic Important Banks (G SIBs), based on the framework established by the Financial Stability Board (FSB). The BCBSs methodology is based on a multi-indicator measurement approach. The indicators are designed to reflect the different aspects of potential negative externalities of a bank's failure and its critical functions for the stability of the financial system.

The European Banking Authority (EBA) has requested all banks with a leverage ratio exposure exceeding 200 billion euro to publish the 13 indicators used in the assessment methodology on an annual basis. Banco BPM is not considered a G-SIB, however with an exposure for leverage ratio that exceeds the aforementioned limit, it is therefore required to disclose and publish these indicators.

The indicators provided below, in thousands of euro, are calculated on the basis of specific instructions by the Basel Committee on Banking Supervision and may therefore not be directly comparable with other disclosures provided by Banco BPM Group.
